IIU seeks witnesses to officer-involved shooting on Archibald Street

The Independent Investigation Unit of Manitoba (IIU) is seeking witnesses to an officer-involved shooting that occurred on July 24, 2017 on Archibald Street in Winnipeg.

The IIU is investigating the incident, which involved a high speed pursuit and officer-involved shooting of a 26-year-old male. The shooting occurred in the 400 block of Archibald Street. The injured male was transported to hospital in critical condition. The IIU was formally notified by the Winnipeg Police Service and investigators were immediately deployed to the scene.
