## Final report now available: IIU concludes investigation into serious injury during RCMP arrest

On December 14, 2022, the Independent Investigation Unit (IIU) issued a media release advising that it had concluded its investigation into an incident in which a female filed a complaint with the Civilian Review and Complaints Commission for the RCMP regarding a broken wrist she sustained during her arrest on September 17, 2021.

As a broken wrist is defined as a serious injury under IIU regulations, the IIU was mandated to investigate.

The final report of the IIU was not released as the affected person had charges pending before the courts as a result of the incident. Those charges have now been disposed and the IIU final report is now available on the IIU website. The details of this investigation were first announced on November 2, 2021.
