Winnipeg Police Service officer charged with driving offences following IIU investigation

The Independent Investigation Unit (IIU) has concluded its investigation into a motor vehicle collision at the intersection of Notre Dame Avenue and Donald Street on April 16 involving a police vehicle and a civilian vehicle. The driver of the civilian vehicle was transported to hospital for treatment for a broken rib. Two police officers were also transported to the hospital, examined and medically cleared.

As a result of the investigation, Winnipeg Police Service Const. Landan Ramage has been charged with failing to use a siren contrary to Sec. 106(2) of the Highway Traffic Act and failure to drive with due regard to safety contrary to Sec. 106 (4) of the act.

The IIU issued a news release on April 18 to advise it had launched an investigation into the incident.

As this matter is now before the courts, the IIU will not comment further.
