IIU investigating motor vehicle collision involving police vehicle

The Independent Investigation Unit of Manitoba (IIU) is investigating a motor vehicle collision that took place on April 16, 2023, in Winnipeg.

On April 17, the Winnipeg Police Service notified the IIU of an incident that occurred around 6 p.m. on April 16. According to the notification, an accident occurred at the intersection of Notre Dame Avenue and Donald Street involving a police vehicle and a civilian vehicle.

The driver of the civilian vehicle was transported to hospital for treatment for a fractured rib. Two police officers were also transported to hospital, examined and medically cleared.

As these injuries are defined by regulation as serious injuries, the IIU is mandated to investigate.

The investigation is ongoing so no further details will be provided at this time.
