

Final report now available: IIU concludes investigation into serious injury sustained by adult female during arrest in Winnipeg

On Sept. 4, 2023, the Winnipeg Police Service notified the IIU of an incident. According to the notification, officers responded to a call for service at a residence on Beaumont Bay, regarding a combative female who had broken into a residence and was assaulting the occupants. Officers advised the affected person that she was under arrest and attempted to take her into custody. The woman resisted being arrested and a use-of-force encounter ensued. The officers and the woman fell to the floor and one of the officers landed on the female's leg. An ambulance was requested and woman was transported to Concordia Hospital where she was diagnosed with a fractured right tibia.

The affected person had charges pending before the court as a result of this incident, which have now been disposed of.
