IIU investigating serious injury related to arrest in Winnipeg

The Independent Investigation Unit of Manitoba (IIU) is investigating the circumstances surrounding the arrest of a female in Winnipeg on Sept. 3.

On Sept. 4, Winnipeg Police Services (WPS) notified the IIU of an incident that resulted in a serious injury that required hospitalization. According to the notification, on Sept. 3 at 11:13 p.m., WPS responded to a call for service regarding a female who had broken into a house and was assaulting people. Once officers arrived on the scene, they were met with a combative female. During the female's arrest, a use of force encounter occurred, resulting in a serious injury. The female was taken to Concordia Hospital, where it was determined she had suffered a fractured right tibia.

As a fractured tibia is defined as a serious injury under the IIU regulations, the IIU is mandated to investigate.

The investigation is ongoing so no further details will be provided at this time.
